

# PARENT INFORMATION 4 – FEBRUARY

### **ATTENDANCE**

As you may have heard on the news, the Department for Education are targeting attendance as one of their priorities. They are stating that all children should have a school attendance rate of **at least 95%**. In the coming weeks, we will be auditing our attendance records and any pupil whose attendance is under 85% will receive a letter. This is for unexplained absences only. It is vitally important that any school absences are reported to the class teacher or school office. These can then be recorded on the school system.

We will be promoting attendance by introducing a monthly attendance award. This will be awarded to the class with the highest overall attendance each month.

#### **HALF-TERM HOLIDAY**

School will **close at 12noon** on Friday 10 February for all pupils. We will be having a movie morning on Friday to celebrate all the fantastic work this half term. School is closed from Monday 13 February-Friday 17 February (inclusive) and will reopen at 8.45am on Monday 20 February.
